PHARMACOLOGICAL ACTION : Etoricoxib is a COX-2 selective inhibitor (approximately 106 times more selective for COX-2 inhibition over COX-1). Like any other COX-2 selective inhibitor Etoricoxib selectively inhibits isoform 2 of cyclo-oxygenase enzyme (COX-2), preventing production of prostaglandins (PGs) from arachidonic acid.

USED FOR : ETORICOXIB TABLETS 90 mg. belong to a family of medicines called non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs). Etoricoxib helps to reduce the pain and swelling (inflammation) in the joints and muscles of people 16 years of age and older with osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis, ankylosing spondylitis and gout.

SIDE EFFECTS : Stomach pain.
Constipation.
Swelling of the legs.
Irregular heartbeat and rhythm.
Increased blood pressure.
Mouth ulcers.
