NAME : Vitamin C 100 + Zinc 40 mg and Vitamin D3 20 mcg Tablets

PHARMACOLOGICAL ACTION : Vitamin C and zinc play important roles in providing adequate nutrition and immune defense. This supplement may be given to prevent or treat certain deficiencies caused by poor nutrition, different diseases, medications, or pregnancy.

Vitamin D (ergocalciferol-D2, cholecalciferol-D3, alfacalcidol) is a fat-soluble vitamin that helps your body absorb calcium and phosphorus. Having the right amount of vitamin D, calcium, and phosphorus is important for building and keeping strong bones.

USED FOR : PROENERVIT-CDZ (VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D3+ZINC) supports the immune system to fight against various diseases and prevents nutritional deficiencies. It is composed of Vitamin C (Ascorbic acid), Vitamin D3 (Cholecalciferol), and Zinc. Vitamin C is an antioxidant that prevents cell damage and boosts immunity.

SIDE EFFECTS : PROENERVIT-CDZ (VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D3+ZINC) is likely safe to consume. In some cases, it may cause side effects like diarrhoea, nausea, and vomiting. These side effects are not common to everyone and usually do not require medical attention. However, if these side effects persist longer, please consult your doctor.

WARNINGS : Let your doctor know if you are allergic to VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D+ZINC SULPHATE or its inactive components. Brief your medical history to the doctor if you have any heart/kidney/liver diseases before starting VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D+ZINC SULPHATE. Pregnant or breastfeeding women should consult their doctor before taking VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D+ZINC SULPHATE. It is advised to limit the alcohol intake while using VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D+ZINC SULPHATE. VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D+ZINC SULPHATE is safe to use in children when suggested by the doctor. Do not store VITAMIN C+VITAMIN D+ZINC SULPHATE above 25
